
DMRF FALL 2019 Molly Appeal for **WAVE 1 RESEARCH FUNDING** **CALL FOR APPLICATIONS**

Submission Deadline **Thursday, May 30th 2019**

Dalhousie Medical Research Foundation's (DMRF) Molly Appeal has been an annual Maritime-wide public fundraising campaign of DMRF since 1980. To date, the Molly Appeal has raised over \$5 million for annual medical research initiatives.

FUNDING PRIORITY:

DMRF invites members of the Dalhousie Medical Research Community to submit research funding applications for the **FALL 2019 Molly Appeal for WAVE 1 Research** (to launch in **September 2019**).

- DMRF welcomes **one application from each of the three components of WAVE 1 Research**.
- **Co-submission from multiple WAVE groups is also acceptable/encouraged.**

MAXIMUM FUNDING REQUEST: \$250,000

APPLICATION CONSULTATION:

- **Applicants are strongly encouraged to discuss their project idea with the respective Wave 1 Lead**, to facilitate building a strong, integrated and collaborative research funding request for the specific area of Wave 1 Research.
- Applicants are **encouraged to consult with the larger FoM research community, to identify areas of greatest need** and to include **signatures of support from Department Heads and multiple researchers** whose work will benefit from funding for the research application.
- Research teams are also encouraged to consult with the **Medical Research Development Office (MRDO)** and the **Associate Dean, Research**, particularly for applications involving core facilities.

CRITERIA:

- **Meet the stated funding priority (Wave 1).**
- **Demonstrate support from other Dalhousie FoM researchers whose work will benefit from this project.**
- **Include signature of Wave 1 Lead (see page 2).**
- **Include a letter of support from Wave 1 Lead.**
This should outline how funding will help enhance the WAVE and faculty as a whole.
- **Provide signatures of support from fellow researchers** who concur that the funding application is for an area of greatest need within the **FoM Wave 1** research community and will promote and enhance collaborative efforts.

- **Provide a relevant and transparent budget. Operational costs are ineligible.**
- **Demonstrate multi-user benefits** for collective research efforts and results **with emphasis on equipment and/or research training programs.**
- Applications for **equipment and/or core facilities** to provide links to **benefits for multi-user research integration**
- Successful application needs **compelling spokespeople** – researchers, clinicians, patients – to educate donors.
The selected applicant must agree to work with DMRF to develop strong research outcomes and impact.
