

## DMRF Kathryn A. Weldon Travel Awards

Dalhousie Medical Research Foundation (DMRF) is pleased to announce its bi-annual travel award program to assist graduate students in the Faculty of Medicine to attend and present their research at a national or international meeting.

Applicants with demonstrated excellence in research in the areas **of Alzheimer's, liver disease or diabetes** will be given first priority as per the declared interest of our benefactor Mrs. Kathryn A. Weldon. If no applications in these areas are received and/or they do not pass scientific peer-review, then applications in other areas of research may be approved.

### Eligibility

Applications are invited from graduate students studying under the supervision of a member of the Faculty of Medicine for the purpose of presenting data (paper or poster presentation) on which the student is an author. The presentation may be at a national or international conference and **must take place within six months** of the application deadline.

### Assessment

On behalf of DMRF, the Faculty of Medicine Research Committee will review applications. Each application will be reviewed according to the quality of the proposed presentation, the relevant contribution of the presentation to the related field, the financial need of the student and supervisor, and the student's research record.

### Value of Award

DMRF Weldon Travel Awards are available currently valued at **\$2,000 each** and can help defray the actual costs of travel, registration, and accommodation. Individuals may receive this award more than once but first time applicants will be given preference.
